#### **EMERGENCY PROCEDURES** 24 HOUR ADVICE IN AN EMERGENCY ONLY: 0800 243 622 IF THIS HAPPENS DO THIS TANKER/VEHICLE Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away. Warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks. **ACCIDENT** Call the emergency services: Dial 111 Caution: Floors may be slippery if wet. Eliminate all ignition sources and naked lights. Use non-sparking equipment. Leave and/or avoid entering confined spaces. Wear overalls, chemical resistant boots and gloves, and safety glasses/goggles. SPILL OR LEAK Respiratory protection (with organic vapour cartridge) is required for any spill other than minor. Exclude non-essential people from the area. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in a sealable container. Wash affected area with water detergent solution. Absorb washings and place in a sealed container. Dispose of to a suitable landfill. **FIRE** Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear protective clothing including self-contained breathing apparatus. Toxic fumes may be released. Keep people away. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical, carbon dioxide or fine water spray. Cool other containers to prevent rupture. Contain run-off. **FIRST AID** IF SWALLOWED Do not induce vomiting. Call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor immediately Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if easy to do so. Continue rinsing. Call the National IF IN EYES Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 or a Doctor if irritation persists. Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 IF ON SKIN 766 or a Doctor if feeling unwell or if rash or irritation occurs. Remove to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Call the National Poisons Centre 0800 764 766 IF INHALED or a Doctor if feeling unwell.
