TANKER/VEHICLE	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away. Warn other traffic. Check for spills and leaks.

SPILL OR LEAK	Caution: Floors may be slippery if wet. Eliminate all ignition sources and naked lights. Use non-sparking equipment. Leave and/or avoid entering confined spaces.
