PRECAUTIONS

STORAGE

GENERAL INFORMATION

Guvnor Gold is a herbicide for the selective pre-emergence control of annual grasses in maize, sweetcorn, asparagus (established), pumpkins and squash.

Weeds controlled: Commonly occurring annual grass weeds including summer grass, barnyard grass, bristle grasses, witch grasses and crowfoot grass.

SOIL RESIDUES

To minimise soil residues, areas treated with Guvnor Gold should be deeply cross-cultivated to ensure maximum dispersal of residues. Certain susceptible crops such as yegrass and some small grain cereals should not be sown in areas which have been treated with Guvnor Gold in the previous 5 months, without first obtaining advice from your local Orion AdriScience representative.

RESISTANCE MANAGEMENT

GROUP K3 HERBICIDE

Guvnor Gold contains s-metolachlor, which belongs to the chloroacetamides chemical family. Resistance to this and other chloroacetamide or oxyacetamide herbicides could develop from excessive use. To minimise this risk, use strictly in accordance with label instructions and rotate use with herbicides with a different mode of action. Consult http://resistance.nzpps.org/index.php for alternative modes of action and details of resistance management strategies (if any) for the crops listed on this label.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Asparagus (established)	Barnyard Grass, Bristle Grasses, Crowfoot Grass, Summer Grass, Witch Grasses	2.4 L	Apply when closing up the beds. Do NOT apply during the cutting season.
Maize, Sweetcom		5 L	Apply to a freshly prepared seedbed immediately after planting and before crop emergence. Do NOT apply after crop emergence, as scorching can occur, and the control of grasses is less effective. Effectiveness is greatly reduced on peat soils. For the control of annual broadleaf weeds, use other products such as AtraflowTM (other than for fathen resistant to triazine herbicides), Dominator® or Orion Nico Ultra, applied as a post emergence spray according to label directions.
Pumpkins, Squash		1L	Apply to a freshly prepared seedbed immediately after planting and before crop emergence. Do NOT exceed the recommended rate of application as crop damage may occur

APPLICATION METHODS

Ground Application: Apply in a minimum of 200 L / ha of water.

MIXING

Partly fill the spray tank with water, and add the required quantity of Guvnor Gold. Maintain agitation through filling and spraying.

COMPATIBILITY

Compatible with most commonly used herbicides in maize and asparagus.

SOIL CONDITIONS/RAINFALL

Best results will be obtained when application is made to a freshly prepared, fine, moist soil, free of trash, with at least 10 mm of rain within 1 week of application. Under drier soil conditions, 30 mm or more of rain within 2-3 weeks is necessary.
