

Corsair™ HERBICIDE



Corsair is unique – a pasture herbicide with the broadest weed spectrum on the market. Based on tried and trusted 2,4-D, it also contains a spike of flumetsulam to enhance control of weeds that have been difficult to control with phenoxies alone.

Used at 4 – 5 L/ha over late autumn, winter and into early spring (depending on situation), Corsair offers exceptional weed control in established pasture.

Used at 2.5 L/ha, Corsair can also be used on new pasture.

Corsair offers the following advantages:

- Extended weed spectrum. Performance on the usual 2,4-D susceptible weeds such as thistles is extended to include weeds such as chickweed, cleavers and mallow (which 2,4-D alone would not control)
- Convenient 'single can' formulation - only otherwise achieved through tank mixing of separate multiple products
- Combining 2 active ingredients from different groups into a single product minimises the risk of resistance developing
- Cost effective broad leaf weed control.

As with other pasture herbicides, Corsair can be damaging to clovers, and clovers should be grazed before application to minimise damage.
