No pre-baiting is required. One feed is sufficient to kill a mouse or rat, but they will continue to eat the bait even after a lethal dose has been eaten. 7 in 1 Go Rodent Blocks can be used both indoors and outdoors. The baits are approved for use as a ground based application in a bait station. Use only with an appropriate bait station. By law this product must only be used in a bait station or as specified on the label.

DIRECTIONS

Eliminate alternative food sources. Do **NOT** place baits in the open, or in areas accessible to children, pets, birds or other animals. Locate the baits in a bait station, or under cover or in a pipe along walls or rafters, and in dark sheltered areas where there are signs of rodent activity. Do **NOT** use in areas liable to flooding. Baits can be nailed or secured in place with wire. Ensure baits cannot be moved from the bait location.

For Mice: Use a single bait block 5m apart, or 2m apart for high infestations

For Rats: Use 1 – 3 blocks 10m apart, or 5m apart for high infestations

Record the location and number of bait stations to assist with later checking and removal. Inspect the baits regularly, and replace every 7 days until no more are being taken.

Baiting for at least 2 weeks will be necessary to reduce rodent numbers. Ensure any unopened baits are removed and safely disposed of when rodent activity has ceased. Where possible, to reduce the risk of secondary poisoning, dead rats and mice should be collected for disposal. Do **NOT** let cats or dogs eat poisoned rats or mice.
